Julia's Grace Foundation helps children fighting cancer and their families by providing support to make the days "normal". Remembering that kids need to be kids and everyone needs a "hug", the Julia's Grace Foundation offers opportunities for special family moments, whether at home, in the hospital or at public events and venues.

Eligibility Criteria

- Program is for children under the age of 18 and their immediate family members.
- Child must be diagnosed with cancer and currently in treatment for childhood cancer.
- Social worker, child life worker or primary physician must refer child and family to the program.
- Eligibility will be determined by Julia's Grace Foundation after receipt of completed application.
- Families give the Julia's Grace Foundation the right to use your child's name and likeness on our website, Facebook page and other media and promotional materials.

Grace Foundation against any and all liability, damages and claims of any kind that may
be connected with or result from participation in a Julia's Grace Foundation "Hug,"

Hug Information

- "Hugs" are simple surprises based on the child in treatment for cancer and his/her family's likes.
- "Hugs" can also be specific requests for an activity or event that a child and family would like to do. These must be local in nature and not require extensive travel.
- "Hugs" are granted based on availability of funds for distribution at the time of the application.

After Submission

- Julia's Grace Foundation understands the time is of the essence and therefore will do its best to respond within 2-3 days after receipt of the completed application.
- Upon review of the application, Julia's Grace Foundation will notify the social worker, child life worker or primary physician of the "hug" being granted.
